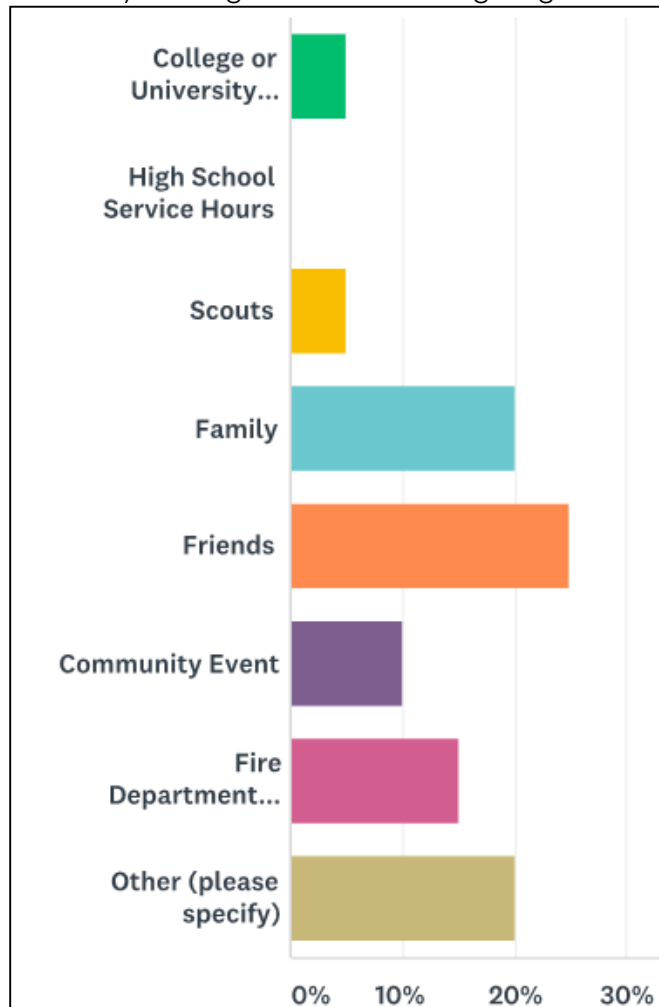


Firefighter Survey Results
