Hydrant Flushing - Week of April 10th

The semi-annual water main flushing program occurs every fall and spring. Flushing fire hydrants and water mains is part of a routine maintenance necessary to maintain the water system and remove sediment from lines. The process of flushing the water system may result in low water pressure, cloudy or discolored water. Please refrain from doing laundry while flushing. The discolored water is not dangerous to your health. Please watch for signs in your neighborhood when flushing will occur.

Residential Update

Residential Development saw one new plat during 2022 which was Brayburn Trails II. It is planned for 139 single family homes once fully completed. There was plenty of activity with 400 new construction building permits issued in 2022. This is an almost 50/50 mixture of attached and detached single family homes in existing developments. There are no current residential development applications in 2023.

Commercial Update

2022 was a banner year for commercial development in Dayton. 7 new buildings were approved. These included the Graco Distribution Facility, Capital Partners Spec Warehouse Building, Alro Steel Manufacturing Facility, Inland Spec Warehouse Building, The Cubes Spec Warehouse Building, Scannell Spec Warehouse Building, and Kwik Trip Gas Station. All of these projects are in various development stages; however, it's expected to have all but 2 (Scannell and Alro Steel) completed by the end of 2023. There is one additional plat that has been approved during 2023 for MTL. This is located at the end of Troy Lane and it's for two buildings, one is a distribution warehouse building, and the other is an office building for Curbside Waste.
