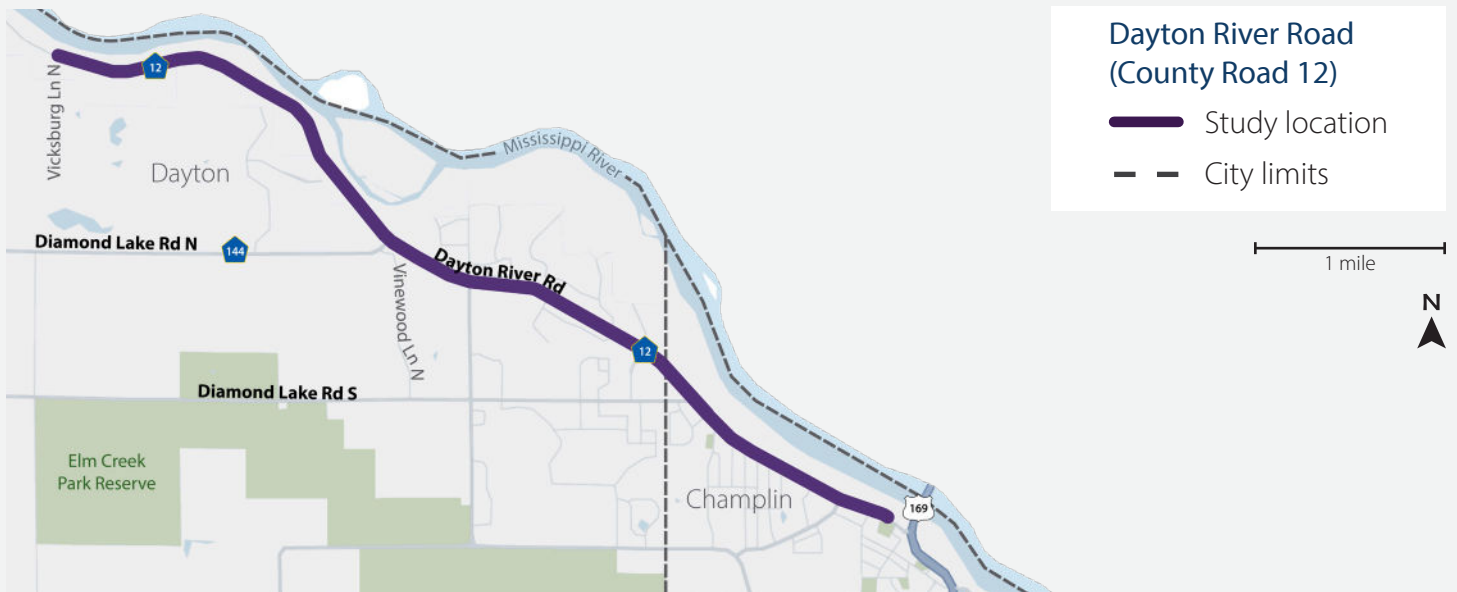

Equitable design

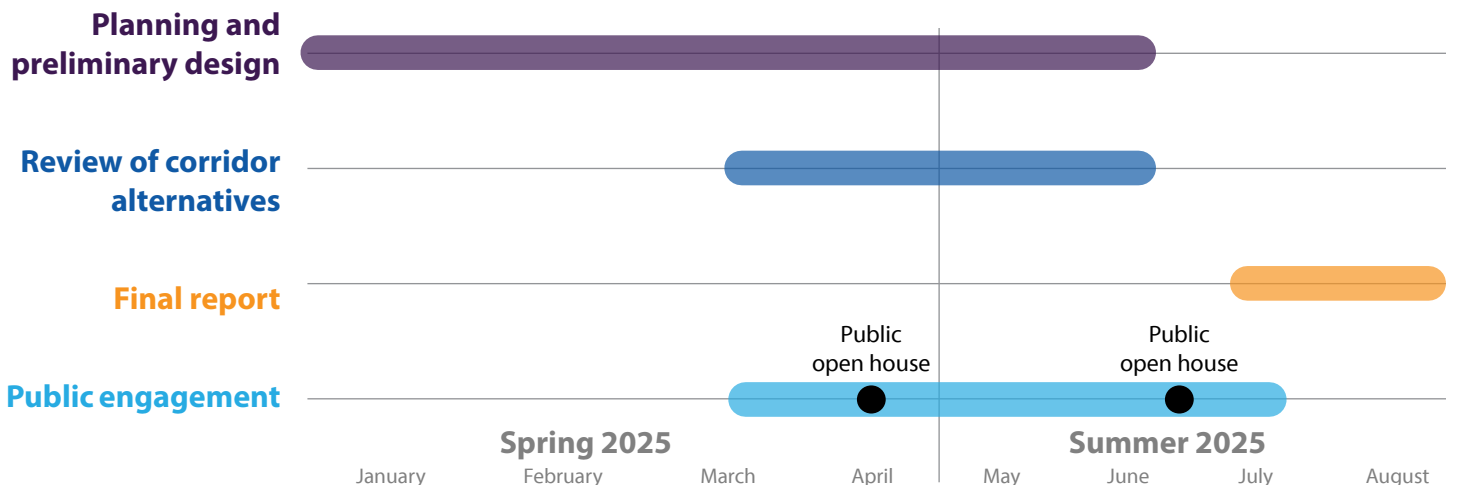
Complete Streets is an approach to roadway design that balances the needs of all roadway users, including people walking, biking, rolling, riding transit, and driving.
