The City of Dayton respectfully asks you to sign your name and send off this included letter to the respective state legislator stated in the letter as soon as possible. These letters are to oppose HF 1987/SF 2229 ("Minnesota Starter Home Act"), HF2140/SF 2231 ("More Homes Right Places Act"), and HF2018/SF 2286 ("Transforming Main Street Act"). All 3 of these bills are detrimental to the zoning authority and power that the City has to maintain the current look and feel of not only your neighborhood, but Dayton as a whole by stripping away local planning and zoning standards that we have today. Dayton is specifically concerned about the broadness of these bills and how they do not allow unique communities, like us, to address their own needs and circumstances.

We as the City of Dayton ask for your help to address these bills head on and not allow for our state legislators to take away the city's ability to control the planning, zoning, and look for more effective ways to create affordable housing that can help Dayton and not broadly accommodate those needs across every community in the State.

We look forward to seeing how this effort from our residents can help Dayton, and ultimately every community, seek an alternate approach that is flexible in nature, workable, practical, involves public input, and includes local decision-making so policies can fit each community's unique needs.
