



Notice of Service Line Materials Inventory

The City of Dayton completed an inventory of the water services within their community per the requirements of the Minnesota department of Health (MDH). During this inventory, the City reviewed available records, construction plans and information submitted by residents to categorize water services within the community. The inventory found that 2768 services were confirmed as non-lead, zero were confirmed as lead or galvanized and 407 services the material was unknown based on available data.
