## **RE: City of Dayton Well 4 Emergency Maintenance Notice**

Well 4 that supplies the Northeast area of Dayton, requires urgent maintenance, the well needs to be offline whilst this work is being completed. While the Emergency Maintenance is being conducted, we will be operating from a single well in the region, which can supply sufficient water for day-to-day usage, but may struggle to maintain fire flow, during peak irrigation times. We are asking residents to be mindful of how much water is being used for irrigation and keep it to the minimum to maintain your lawns and landscaping. Lawns and landscaping require 1 inch of water per week to maintain a healthy lawn and landscape.

This work is scheduled to begin on Tuesday, September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Staff does not have a timeline available at this time, once it is available we will post it on the website and social media. Please view the map of the northeast area affected by the well shutdown.
