All preliminary plat applications are expected to be reviewed within 120-days (State Statute does not require preliminary plats to be reviewed within 60-days).

\*Delays in receiving revised plans will delay the timeline. Plans changes should be submitted within a week of receiving feedback. \*\*Rescheduling and delays may occur during holiday season
