



Pineview Lane N and Oakview Lane N Improvements Project

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. Will I still receive my mail during construction?

- a. Temporary mailboxes will be set up at an accessible location outside of the construction limits so that the post office may still deliver your mail to you during construction. If you have mobility limitations that may restrict your ability to get mail at a different location, please inform the City of Dayton or Wenck staff.

2. Will my garbage and recycling service be interrupted during construction?

- a. Garbage and recycling service will continue during construction. Additional information regarding any required changes to pick-up time or location will be provided once construction begins.

3. Will I be able to get into my driveway during construction?

- a. Access to your home will be maintained for as much of the project duration as possible. There will be days or times at which your access will be restricted, however these times will be communicated to you beforehand so that you can make alternative plans for parking and accessing your home. Special circumstances may be accommodated if possible if staff is notified ahead of time.

4. Pineview Lane doesn't currently have curb, will this project be adding it?

- a. The project includes installing concrete curb and gutter between the driving lane and the trail along the west side of Pineview Lane. Curb will also be added in other areas to manage drainage.

Also, the project includes replacing bituminous curb along Oakview Lane.

5. I have landscaping, irrigation, and/or invisible fencing along or near the existing road, how will these be impacted as part of the improvements?

- a. Any landscaping, irrigation lines, or invisible fencing located in the public right-of-way is the responsibility of the homeowner to salvage prior to construction starting. Otherwise,

these items will likely be damaged during construction. Landscaping will not be restored in the right-of-way following construction.

6. Can I get my driveway fixed while contractors are repairing the streets?

- a. Some contractors may decide to take on additional private work outside of the project scope while they are working on the project, such as replacing driveways or additional utility work. This is up to the discretion of the contractor and is not guaranteed. Work within private property, outside of the project scope, must be facilitated between the homeowner and contractor. City of Dayton may provide contractor contact information upon request.

7. What hours of the day will they be working?

- a. Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, and Saturdays from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. No work will take place on Sundays unless there is an emergency or special circumstance.

8. Will I be charged for the project?

- a. The City of Dayton does not assess for street improvements. Residents will not be assessed for this project.

9. When will the project begin? How long will it take?

- a. Construction is anticipated to begin in May and will likely continue through the end of November. Work is expected to take place during the spring of 2021, and the project is scheduled to be completed in summer 2021.
